

DALTON-LE-DALE PARISH COUNCIL

USE OF NOTICE BOARDS

- 1. The Parish Council has three Notice Boards located in the following locations;**
 - I. The bus stop at Dalton Heights.
 - II. At the entrance to Dalton Grange.
 - III. In the grounds of the Parish Hall in Dalton-le-Dale

- 2. The use of these notice boards is predominately for the purpose of the Parish Council to meet its statutory duty to displaying notices and information concerning the running of the council for the benefit of its parishioners.**

- 3. The Parish Council recognises that it needs to support its various community groups, local organisations and local businesses who reside/operate within its boundaries and whose work and efforts may benefit its parishioners.**
 - I. The Parish Council will therefore allow the above mentioned groups access to the notice boards to display suitable information/notices/promotional material that will be of benefit to them and provide useful information or benefit to the parishioners.
 - II. Use of the notice boards will be monitored by Members of the Council and the Clerk, with access keys to the units held by the Community Association, Members of the Council and the Clerk.
 - III. Should the Clerk require space in the notice boards for notices necessary to conduct the council business, the Clerk will remove such items as necessary to create sufficient space to fulfil the parish councils needs.

- 4. Members of the Council and the Clerk withhold the right to decline or remove any such notices that are deemed unsuitable for display in these notice boards and remove notices that are out of date.**
